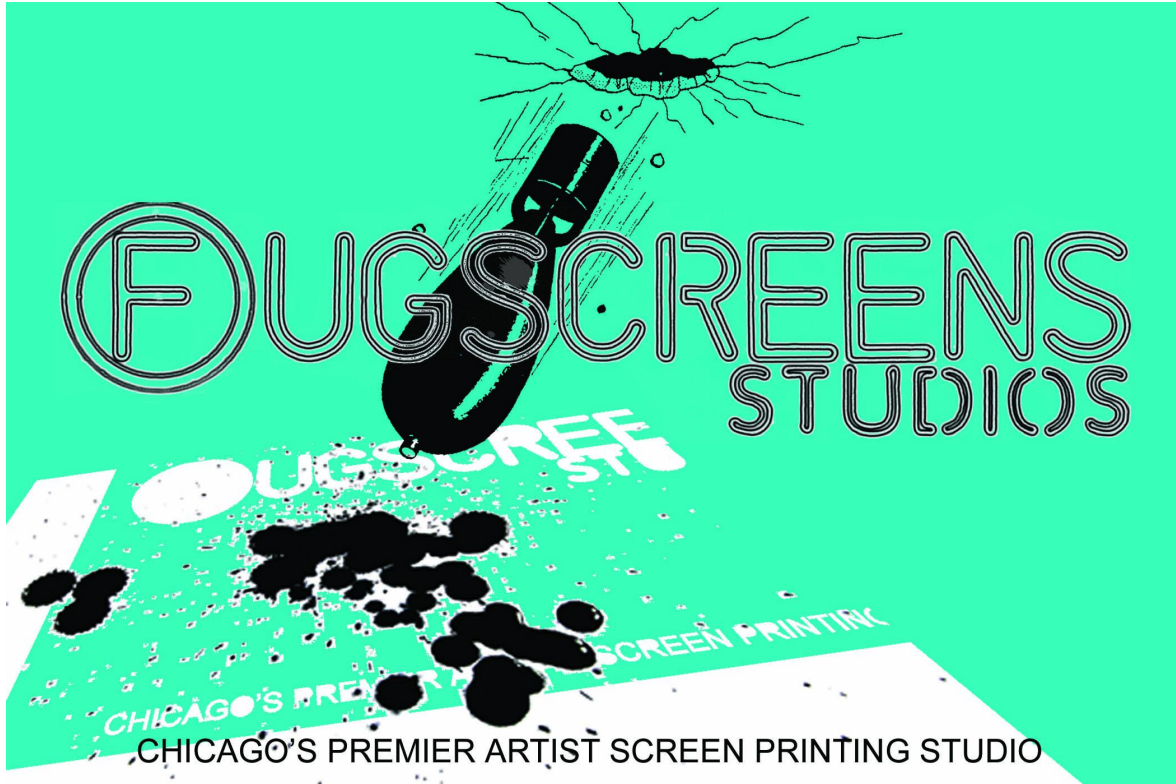

Introduction to the FugScreens Internship Program

The FugScreens Internship Program provides the courses, equipment and space for upcoming artists who wish to develop a body of screen-printing work for college credit or business experience, but lack the resources to do so independently. FugScreens hopes to encourage emerging Chicago artists to produce high quality work in a friendly and exciting environment.

FugScreens will provide the Intern with materials and a high quality facility to work on screen-printing projects. We aim to provide knowledge in all facets of screen printing, as well preparation for one to build his or her studio and start a business of their own. During the Internship, Interns will have weekly scheduled access to the studio. FugScreens staff will also be available to provide guidance and feedback on technical aspects of work, from building materials, working on computer programs, learning to develop business skills and much more. The intern will also have the option to host demonstrations or shows at FugScreens. At the conclusion of the internship, FugScreens will host a reception displaying the work created.

FugScreens does not have the ability to assist in transportation or housing and suggests mostly Chicago residents to apply at this time. FugScreens will provide all basic materials (a full list is available on the website) and will make exceptions for whatever the intern decides to print on (paper, wood, plastic etc).

We aim to provide an internship for individual artists. Proposals may be for a traditional edition of screen prints, textile work or a less conventional use of the medium.

The intern will be expected to meet periodically (to be established at the beginning of the Residency) with the Director of FugScreens to share ideas and works in progress. Applications finalists may be asked to meet with FugScreens staff to discuss the proposed project in detail.

The intern will be assessed and supervised as to make ensure studio rules and guidelines are adhered to. Thereafter, the intern time at the studio is at the discretion of FugScreens.

FugScreens reserves the right to restrict material and facility use to any and all of its interns.

FEES

Refundable Deposit: \$150, returned 15 days after the last month of studio use.

Contract Length: 30 days from start date (first date of use of the studio)

RULES

All guidelines and regulations must be strictly upheld, any breach of these regulations may result in the intern artist's contract and stay at FugScreens to be terminated.

- Guests may only accompany residents to the studio with express permission from the Director.
- Any damage to studio equipment will result in payment from the intern to fix or replace said equipment.
- Consumption of drugs or alcohol on the studio premises will not be tolerated.
- FugScreens is not responsible for any injuries that intern or resident guests at the studio premises.
- Spaces and equipment used by residents must be put back and restored to a working order for the next person to use.
- All interns must wear closed toe shoes and no heels, to prevent accidents.
- No pets are allowed on studio premises.
- Any violent behavior towards anyone while at FugScreens Studios is subject to immediate termination of contract.
- No outside chemicals are will be brought to FugScreens Studios without direct consent form the director.
